CLASS PROPHECY

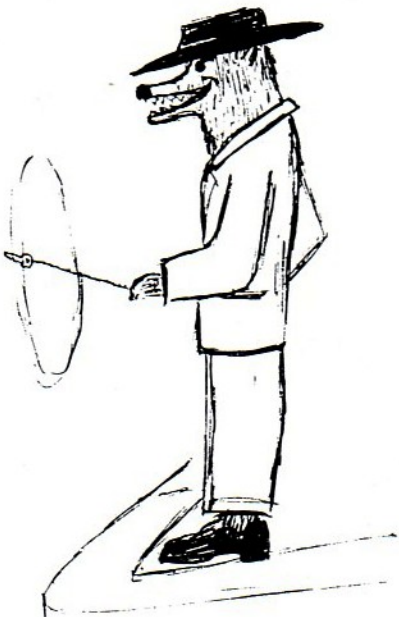

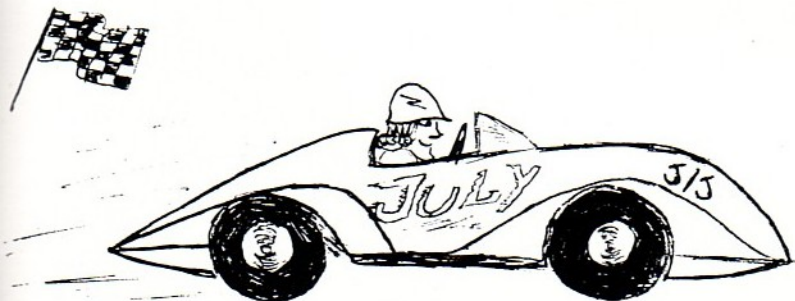

I, GARY LENGKEEK, will my ability to keep silent in class to GAYE WALKER.

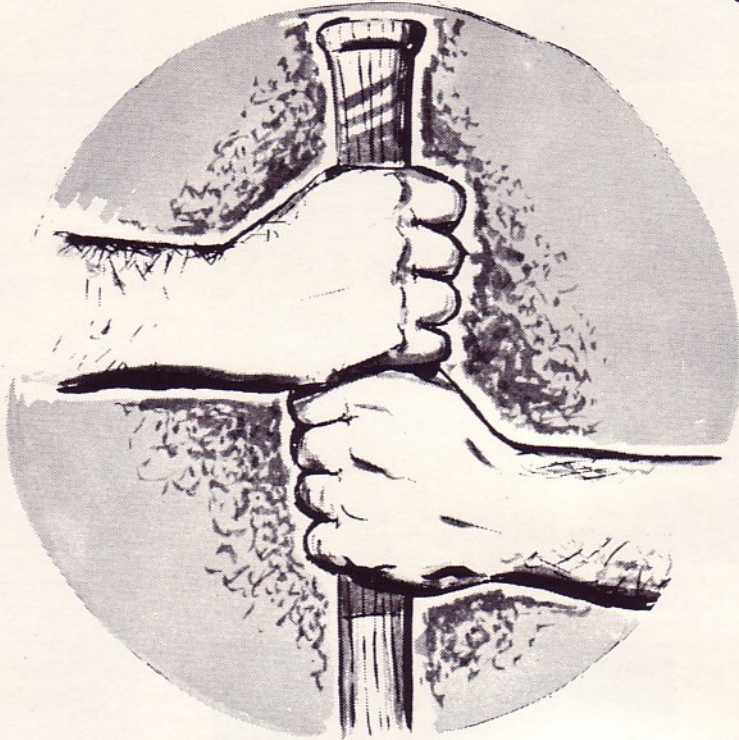
